Length: We will do the adventure courses named *castor*, *écureuil*, *renard* and *cougar*, for a total duration of about three hours.

Dressing code: This activity is entirely outside and will be held rain or shine. We recommend you wear the appropriate clothing for all kind of weather. It is strongly recommended you wear good walking shoes, gloves as well as tight clothing. You should also attach your hair and bring a bottle or gourd that can be locked to your clothing.

Cost: 40 \$, including transportation from and to Université Laval and the Arbraska adventure course.

Meal: There is nowhere to buy food on the site.
